Outcome

 *Prompt to display allergen information after a PLU is entered.*

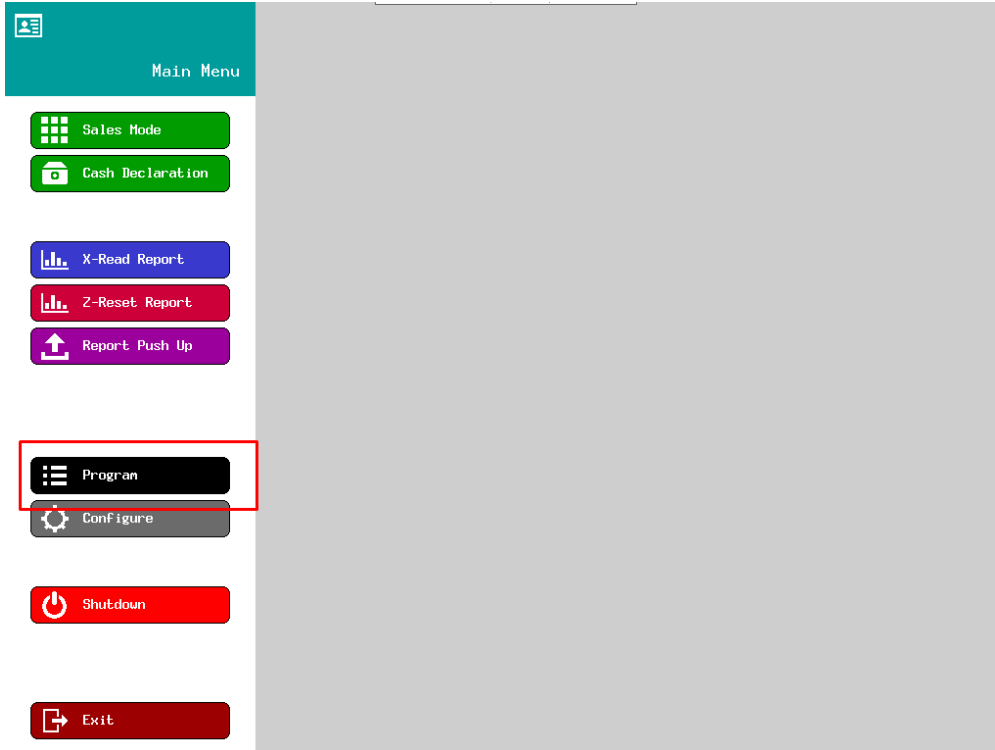
Allergen messages are used to display important information relating to a PLU. In particular, ingredients that are known to cause some people issues such as peanut butter.

Examples:

1. When selling a sandwich that contains peanut the server is prompted with a message to notify the customer before completing the sale that can be accepted or declined.

*** Start Of Self Help Instructions ***

1. Exit sales screen and Select the PROGRAM button.



2. From the PLU tab select 'ALLERGEN'



3. Set the allergen message to display the desired text, there is a total of 20 messages.

- Select the PLU requiring the allergen information, select the OPTION2 tab and choose all applicable messages by ticking beside each entry. Repeat for all remaining PLU's.

- On the same screen select system option. You have the ability to trigger the Allergen message every time the item is sold within the same transaction, by default the message will only appear once for each unique item within the same transaction. To enable the message to appear for the same product within the same transaction enable 'ALLERGEN ASK EVERY TIME'. Press OK to save and exit.
